

Certified Trainer Supervisor Credential

Domestic violence is one of the most challenging case issues facing child welfare and other family service agencies. Handling it well requires specific domestic violence-informed knowledge and skills to increase confidence and ability to address these cases. However, most child welfare and other human service professionals have received little to no training or education related to supervising domestic violence casework.

Why is it so important for Certified Trainers to deliver Domestic Violence-informed Training Specifically for Supervisors?

- Supervisors are the front-line decision-makers in most cases.
- Supervisors act as coaches to their workers, particularly new workers. Skills and habits are often heavily shaped by supervision.
- Supervisors have an important quality assurance role to play, reviewing and guiding their workers' practice.
- Supervisors influence the decisions of their managers through the information they share and the concerns they raise.
- Supervisors have a responsibility to monitor and manage the safety of their workers.

Specific training for supervisors is strongly recommended as part of any agency's effort to promote organization-wide and system-wide domestic violence-informed change.

This Credential will allow Certified Trainers to support the improvement of supervisors' ability to use a coaching approach to:

- Identify and address common safety concerns workers face;
- Guide their social workers' skills and habits;
- Make informed front-line decisions;
- Influence the decisions of their managers; and
- Support the wider system's change efforts.

Credential Objectives

Credential training is focused on three competency areas:

- Knowledge, skills and attitudes related to connecting supervisory practice to the CORE concepts of the Safe & Together™ Model;
- Knowledge, skills and attitudes related to the Key Concepts for Domestic Violence-Informed Supervisory Practice;
- Knowledge, skills and attitudes related to delivering the Supervisors Training content and related training activities.

The training prerequisites are:

- Completion of the Trainer Certification Process
- Completion of the 2-day Supervisor Training (in-person), 3-day Supervisor Training (in-person), OR the Virtual Supervisor Training (in Virtual Academy) with a score of 80%+ on posttest.

Cost: \$795 USD. Starting Date: 31 August 2020. The course takes place over four weeks. The commitment includes 3-4 hours of course work per week, including discussion posts, action planning and one weekly assignment.
